You will be allocated 24 weeks to complete this qualification as an online, home study approach

Course Description

You will explore safeguarding, including key related legislation and instances of serious failures to protect the vulnerable. You will learn how to recognise the signs of abuse or harm and how to respond if it is disclosed or suspected. You will learn about the Prevent duty which aims to reduce the threat of terrorism in the UK. You will also explore what radicalisation, extremism and terrorism are. You will learn about inappropriate and illegal online activity and consequences of terror-related grooming, downloading and sharing illegal material. You will explore a range of online risks, including stalking and identity theft. You will examine behavioural changes that result from inappropriate and illegal online activity and where to seek advice and support for online-related issues.

How Will I Be Assessed
