Topics Covered

Write simple sentences; write and spell common words correctly; fill in simple forms and recognise and write letters of the alphabet.

Recognise common signs and symbols; read a short piece of text and answer questions from the text correctly.

Listen and respond to requests for personal information; make statements of fact and ask questions using the WH question words: when, what, why, where, who and how.

How will I be assessed?

There are 3 formal assessments in Reading, Writing, and Speaking & Listening to gain your qualification. Your tutor will assess your progress regularly and provide you with support and guidance to successfully achieve your qualification.
