Topics Covered

Present information in an appropriate format and construct simple and compound sentences using correct punctuation; use appropriate adjectives to describe people, places or objects; use upper and lower case letters appropriately and record personal details in a form correctly.

Trace and understand the main points in a text; obtain information from texts; recognise key words in a sentence (nouns, adjectives, verbs, preposition); understand and identify the different purposes of short, straightforward texts.

Speak clearly to be understood; make requests and ask questions to obtain information in everyday context; express likes and dislikes and follow the main points of a discussion making appropriate contributions.

How will I be assessed?

There are 3 formal assessments in Reading, Writing, and Speaking & Listening to gain your qualification. Your tutor will assess your progress regularly and provide you with support and guidance to successfully achieve your qualification.

What are the entry requirements and enrolment process?

You will have an initial assessment to identify the correct level for you to begin your learning.
