### Description

This is the next step on your journey to gain ESOL qualifications to support you in work, life and further education opportunity. You will learn in a safe, supportive environment that will give you the confidence and skills to develop speaking, reading and writing in English. It will support you to be more independent, to access services and travel confidently within your local and regional community.

### Topics Covered

Plan and draft writing; structure and sequence the main points of writing in short paragraphs; proofread and correct own writing for grammar, punctuation and spelling; complete forms with some complex features (open responses, constructed response and additional comments.

Trace and understand the main events of text of more than one paragraph; understand and tell the difference between purposes of texts; extract the main points and ideas and predict words from context; identify organisational features of text and use them to locate information; know when it is necessary to read every word to locate specific information.

Listen for the gist of explanation, instructions or narrative in face -to-face interactions; listen for details in narratives and explanations; listen for relevant and new information in live presentations; respond to a request for information and follow and participate in a discussion.

## How will I be assessed?

There are 3 formal assessments in Reading, Writing, and Speaking & Listening to gain your qualification. Your tutor will assess your progress regularly and provide you with support and guidance to successfully achieve your qualification.

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## What are the entry requirements and enrolment process?

You will have an initial assessment to identify the correct level for you to begin your learning.
