Entry Requirements

You must be a resident of the Liverpool City Region.

This course is ideal for anyone who is interested in art, craft and design.

You will need to undertake a short, simple, initial assessment in English if you don't have an English qualification already. You must be working at Entry 2 level or above to support you accessing the materials and any writing, against the criteria, where necessary.

This course is suitable for anyone just starting out with creativity/making or learners who have a basic knowledge of art & design but wish to develop their confidence, skills and abilities further.

Designing your own makes, using the materials, equipment and techniques available
Realising your own unique crafts, following demonstrations, using the given materials, equipment, techniques and processes

How will I be assessed?

The portfolio is assessed by your tutor against the qualification criteria. Your makes, although they may be displayed for a time, will be yours to take home. You will be given supportive feedback from your tutor, on a weekly basis, to help you develop your skills and ensure you are on track to complete your qualification.
