Around 15% of people have a learning difficulty, which means they can find it harder to learn certain skills. If you're looking to improve your understanding and awareness of learning difficulties, this is the course for you. You will learn about a range of specific learning difficulties, including ADHD, dyslexia and dyscalculia. Building your knowledge and learning about characteristics and how specific learning difficulties can affect children and adults in different ways. You will look at the importance of early diagnosis, the various assessment methods available to diagnose specific learning difficulties and how individuals can be supported to gain, start and continue with study and employment. This qualification is suitable for anyone looking to build their knowledge of dyslexia and other learning difficulties
