You must hold an Entry 3 Literacy qualification and be willing to continue to work towards L1 Literacy qualification

You must be a resident of the Liverpool City Region, age 19+ and lived in the EU for 3 years.

You will be expected to undertake a short initial assessment that will help us to support you during your learning.

It's suitable for learners with little or no experience of childcare, who are thinking of a career working with children. This L1 qualification is a good introduction to childcare in early years environments, such as pre-schools, nurseries and the childminding sector, studying children from birth to 5 years 11 months.

Management and organisation in an early years setting
Roles and responsibilities in an early years setting

There is NO work placement requirement on this course.

How will I be assessed?

Successful learners will achieve the NCFE CACHE L1 Award in an Introduction to Early Years Settings.

PLEASE NOTE: If you want to progress onto CACHE L2 Supporting Teaching & Learning, after completing the CACHE L1 Certificate, you will need to work towards a L2 Literacy and numeracy qualification.

What will this course lead to?

On successful completion, you may be able to enrol onto the L1 certificate in Caring for Children or onto to L2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning. Further leading to a potential career in schools or progression onto a L3 Teaching Assistant qualification.
