An opportunity to enjoy a relaxing beginners photography class, in a friendly and supportive setting. Enjoy learning about certain elements of early photography, including the mechanisms of traditional cameras and about influential Photographers through history. Consider further Photographers work, chosen for links to the theme Myths & Legends, then try out creative photographic tasks and techniques for yourself.

What will I Learn?

Over this short course, you will consider how photography has changed perceptions and ways of seeing both ourselves and the world. We will look at the role photography has played in truth telling. As well as lies. As a class, we will look at and discuss the work of different Photographers, including those work that relates to the theme Myths & Legends.

Your Tutor will also set mini photographic assignments that offer opportunities to try out creative compositions, techniques and pre and post-production effects for yourself.

No experience necessary.

Is there any entry requirements?

Must be a resident of Liverpool City Region resident. Provide documentation to allow you to access Adult Learning.

How will I be assessed?

This is an NCFE accredited community learning course. Tasks help you build a body of coursework, assessed by your Tutor, who will give you verbal and written feedback to ensure success.

How long is the course for?

12 week course

How much does the course cost?

Free. All materials provided.

What can I do after the course?

The course is intended to build your creative skills, confidence and self-esteem in Photography. You could consider further Photography / Creative Industries related courses.

NB. A photography/arts education can lead to college and university placements. Also work in multi-media and the creative industries sectors.

Do I need to bring anything with me?

A smart phone with camera is the only equipment required. All other learning materials will be provided.

Optional Icebreaker:

Students are invited to tell us about a favourite myth or legend of theirs.

Is there anything else I need to know?

Being creative with visual arts, including Photography, has been known to improve a sense of happiness and wellbeing. This is one of those courses!
